1. Course Synopsis

This course aims to meet the needs of international students seeking entry into local government school. We offer courses for all target levels from Primary 2 to Secondary 3. Upon completion of the course, students will be familiar with the different requirements of the various examinations and be ready to sit for any school entrance examinations such as the CEQ*, AEIS and S-AEIS tests.

We focus on the two main subjects that are being tested ie English Language and Mathematics. For English, we cover the essential components which include reading comprehension, writing, speaking and listening skills as well as grammar and vocabulary. As for Mathematics, we cover the essential reasoning skills, numerical calculations, algebraic manipulations, data analysis, measurement, spatial visualisation, use of mathematical tools and estimation.

2. Admission Criteria

Students will be admitted based on age criteria* and education requirement. Please refer to the table below

Primary 2	7 to 9+	At least completed Primary 1 or equivalent in home country
Primary 3	8 to 10+	At least completed Primary 2 or equivalent in home country
Primary 4	9 to 11+	At least completed Primary 3 or equivalent in home country
Primary 5	10 to 12+	At least completed Primary 4 or equivalent in home country
Secondary 1	12 to 14+	At least completed Primary 6 or equivalent in home country
Secondary 2	13 to 15+	At least completed Secondary 1 or equivalent in home country

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Secondary 3	14 to 16+	At least completed Secondary 2 or equivalent in home country
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*The age ranges are for new international students seeking admission and former international students seeking re-admission into schools as per MOE website.
